On August 22, 1962 in the small town of Hughes, Arkansas a boy was born to Eugene and Ethel Mae McClendon Jones. They named him Jerry Lee, he was the first child born to Eugene and Ethel Mae. Jerry would grow up to become a loving son and brother.

Also fondly known as Big Boy, Jerry was a kind loving young man who basically

grew up in Forrest City, Arkansas. Growing up on Water Street he would be seen

following his Auntie around all the time. When the family moved to Turner Circle

we came in contact with Brother and Sister Alneather Forest and began attending

Church with the Church of God under the leadership of the late Pastor Frank Miller. Jerry was active in Sunday School and other areas of the Church.

One of Jerry's passions was wrestling; he would be found glued to the TV set on

Saturday mornings watching the Wrestling on Channel five. Later in life Jerry would become a Wrestler himself meet and wrestle some of those same guys that

Wrestling Circuit as "The Atomic Dog" and lived up to that name.

Jerry spent most of his adult life in Chicago and Calumet City, Illinois where he worked in Security. On July 05, 2003 Jerry was United in Holy Matrimony to Wanda Corbin; to this Union two children were born, Jazmine and Jerry Jr.

Jerry relocated to Forrest City in July 2023 to be near his Aunt Margaree who was

more like a sister to him. Pastor Forest went to Jerry's apartment and held Bible

Study with him once a week. Jerry was preceded in death by his parents, grandparents: Eddie and Catherine Jones and Claude and Margaret Key Boyd;

his brothers: Dale Eugene "Poki" Walker, Jr., Eugene "Lil Jr" Jones, Jr., Michael

Ray "Big Mike" Jones and David Jones.
